Pastors Pericope Paragraph

(a "pericope" is a selected reading from scripture used as a lesson at worship)

A house divided against itself cannot stand. Yet Jesus appears to reject His own immediate family ("house"). Nothing comes between Him and His devotion to God (Gospel). Adam and Eve hide from their Creator because they have rejected His sovereignty - believing the Tempter's doubt inducing question - trying to be their own gods. Consequences resound (1st lesson). "We do not lose heart" because our "house" (home) is in eternity (2d lesson).
